

TCSU COMMUNAL STUDY ROOM – WOLSON SEMINAR SOUTH:

23rd April – 14th June 2019 (inclusive)

During Easter Term 2019, Wolfson Seminar Room South has been assigned to TCSU for communal study. Use of the room must comply with the following conditions.

Conditions of Use

1. This facility is to be used by Trinity students only.
2. As this is a residential block, noise levels will need to be kept to a minimum, particularly when leaving in the evening.
3. Wolfson Seminar South will be opened by the Porters at 9am and locked at 12 midnight daily.
4. The room will be open seven days a week, and Housekeeping will clean the room before 9am each working day (i.e. Monday to Friday but not weekends).
5. Personal belongings (including books/revision notes etc.) should not be left unattended in the room at any time. The College (and Housekeeping) takes no responsibility for any lost or damaged items.
6. Students using the room must ensure that the room is left tidy and all rubbish is disposed of. If students take any food or drink into the room, they must clear up any mess themselves.
7. No alcohol should be consumed.
8. Students may not use the kitchens in the building.
9. The TCSU are responsible for any damage to the room, and will be charged for it.
10. Students are reminded that the College's Code of Discipline applies to all activities held in the room.

If it appears that these conditions are not being met at any time, the Porters, on behalf of the Junior Bursar or the Dean, will lock the room and stop access with immediate effect.
