

Amalgamated Clubs Committee Report

24 February 2016

The new Amalgamated Clubs Committee has met once more to conclude the 2015-16 allocation recommendations.

- 1) Recall from the Committee's report of 26 January 2016, that £77,360 was transferred to the Amalgamated Clubs Fund, in addition to the reserve then of £55,248.
- 2) The Council agreed on 29 January 2016 to the Committee's first round of recommendations to transfer a sum of £56,130 to pay the CUSU subscription fee, and to fund grants to the TCSU, the BA Society, and eighteen other clubs and societies.
- 3) The Council agreed on 12 February 2016 to the Committee's second round of recommendations to transfer a sum of £28,438 to fund grants to eight clubs and societies (including a substantial additional grant to the Field Club and a minor additional grant to the Jewish Society.)
- 4) This leaves a total of £48,040 in the Amalgamated Clubs Fund.
- 5) The Committee has finally received the remaining delinquent paperwork, and now **recommends** a third (and final) round of allocations for the 2015-16 year, totalling £1,875 for grants to two more clubs. See the attached spreadsheet. This leaves £46,165 in reserves.

The following item is for information:

- 6) Trinema (Trinity's Cinema Society) has submitted a proposal to buy a high-quality data projector, screen and sound system for its film screening, and to lend to other Trinity societies and clubs for their events. They argue that the equipment in the Winstanley Lecture Theatre is inadequate. The estimated cost of their proposal, which has received the endorsement of five other societies, is around £2,000. The Amalgamated Clubs Committee have agreed to defer making a recommendation until further details of the proposal (such as storage and booking arrangements) are worked out.
